EVENT DETAILS

Event Dates: Friday 12th, Saturday 13th & Sunday 14th November, 2021.

Event Site: Hampton Street, Bridgetown & Community Hub Memorial Park

Busking is a great way for you to showcase your talents, get experience performing and more exposure. Buskers are permitted to put their 'hat out' so it's also a great opportunity to raise some funds as well as sell your music.

Busking opportunities are available on both Friday and Saturday – the majority being on Saturday during the Street Party with some limited performance periods and locations available on the Sunday.

Note that there are unpowered sites/busking stations available. But VERY LIMITED powered sites

BUSKING – TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2021

GENERAL

PLEASE NOTE: **THE MAIN ROAD WILL NOT BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC**

SO BUSKERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ENCROACH OR BLOCK FOOTPATHS

1. Buskers are to treat other buskers, customers and event personnel with respect. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.
2. Buskers must follow all directions/instructions issued by event personnel.
3. Blues at Bridgetown Inc. reserves the right to decline any application. Decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. Buskers are responsible for any damage they cause to other property.
5. Buskers may not sell any product or item that has not been approved prior to the event.
6. The following goods are not permitted: • Weapons or imitation weapons (including toys) • Hazardous or flammable goods • 'Fun string' and 'silly string' type products • Shaving cream • Any goods prohibited by law.
7. Failure to comply with any Term or Condition will adversely affect any application for a future event. It may also result in you being removed from the event site.
8. No dogs or other animals are permitted
9. There is no parking provided for Buskers. There is ample parking in surrounding streets and carparks during this year's event.

BUSKING HOURS & SITE ALLOCATION

10. Buskers are allocated a performance/busking time period and site at the discretion of Blues at Bridgetown Inc. in the best interests of the Festival.
11. Buskers are not permitted to perform/busk at any location at any other time.
12. Blues at Bridgetown Inc. reserves the right to reallocate Busking Sites and/or reschedule performance/busking times at anytime as/if required for any operational reason(s).
13. Busking Site locations will not be the same as in previous years due to changes to event layouts.
14. Not all Busking Sites are shaded. Buskers should ensure they have adequate sun as well as rain protection for inclement weather.

PERFORMERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

15. Performers under the age of 18 years at the time of the event must be under the care of a parent or guardian.

BUSKER'S EQUIPMENT

16. Buskers must bring all their own equipment.
17. Equipment must be placed with care as to not create trip hazards.
18. Equipment and goods must be carried or trolleyed back to vehicles. Care must be taken as the area is crowded with pedestrians.

BUSKER'S POWER & ELECTRICAL

19. All electrical equipment including power cables and generators must have passed inspection and be tagged by a licensed electrical contractor.
20. Blues at Bridgetown Inc. production personnel may impound non-tagged electrical equipment including power cables or non-compliant generators. Impounded items can be collected at the conclusion of the event.
21. Blues at Bridgetown Inc. will have a licensed electrician on-call to offer a test and tag service during bump-in. The charge will be \$55 (including GST) per electrical item.
